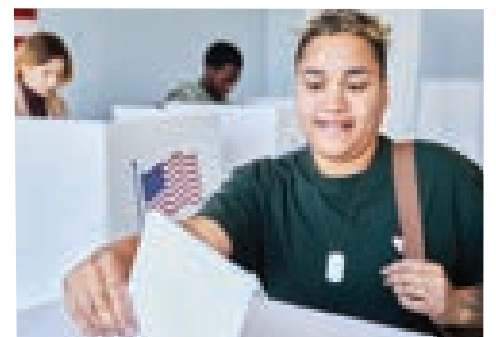
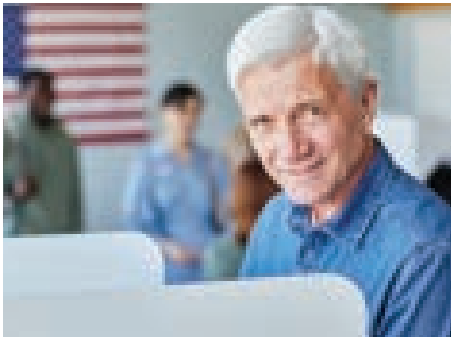
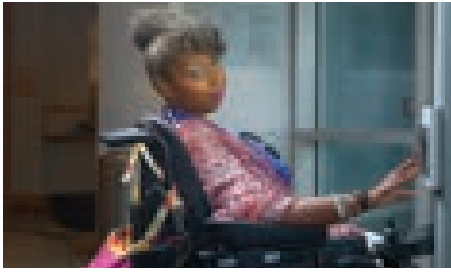


Questions about your voting rights?



People with disabilities have a right to:

- Vote at a physically accessible polling place with accessible parking
- Use an accessible voting machine
- Vote curbside
- Vote privately and make their own choices
- Get help from a person of their choice or an election worker
- Vote if they have a guardian unless a court determines they cannot
- Skip the line if they have a mobility disability
